

Description

Welcome to the heart of Slavonia, in one of the 10 Croatian tourist regions. The starting point of the excursion is baroque town of Požega, idyllically nested between five green mountains at 152 m above sea level.

Požega and its sights are best to meet by enjoying its enogastronomic offer and tradition.

Požega is a place full of interesting stories, legends, and rich traditions that the Slavs respect very much. Some of the most important elements of traditions such as squares, history, gorgeous Slavonian gastronomic traditions through the dishes of Taste of Slavonia and the local cultural and historical values will also be experienced in this excursion.

You will meet the baroque town of Požega, its charming squares and cathedral. You will feel the spirit of Cehovska Street, experience the Požega through walking and conducting professional guide.

After visiting Požega, you will experience UNESCO Nature Park Papuk through walking conducted by professional guide.

Then you will visit family agricultural farm Larva where you can experience the lifestyle of old Slavonia and taste the Slavonian specialties in the way you have never tasted.

You will experience Slavonia just the way it is - fast enough, yet slowly enough with all the senses. You will be thrilled by the combination of hills under grapevine, grain fields, oak forests, Slavonian roads, history and culture with many interesting and authentic tastes. So come and experience a different and authentic heart of Slavonia, experience Požega.

- Arrival in Požega, Trg Svetog Trojstva (The Holy Trinity Square)

Požega is cultural and historical pearl of the "Golden Valley". The town is located in the heart of the valley surrounded by picturesque mountains of Psunj, Papuk, Krndija, Dilj and Požeška gora. Since the 13th century, the city is a royal property, later the seat of the Požega County, a

Turkish sanctuary, and after the exile of the Turks in 1688. it became a significant cultural center. Požega got the name "Slavonian Athens" in 19th century when many cultural societies were founded, many of which still operate today. The ornament of the town is the Baroque Holy Trinity Square with the Cathedral of St. Theresa of Avila, and specially beautiful historic city center. An unforgettable experience are the numerous forest paths and town viewpoints on country roads, paths through fields and vineyards, and in the vicinity of the city there are plenty of well-diversified cycling routes in really picturesque landscapes.
